



# INTERNATIONAL NEGOTIATION TECHNIQUES TRAINING

# 'effective negotiation in international environment'

On January 20<sup>th</sup>, the Netherlands Institute of International Relations Clingendael will provide a one-day-training on International Negotiation Techniques at the Netherlands Institute for Higher Education (NIHA). The training is organized by NIHA with the participation of Netherlands Education Association (HED) and it is designed to address the complexities of multilateral negotiations.

The course specifically focuses on international negotiations as a method for peaceful dispute settlement between states and/ or other organizations. It addresses different methods of negotiation through determining and examining types of conflict situations and handling modes. Altogether, the seminar aims to contribute to one's skills in tackling multiparty conflicts.

The training which is certified by Netherlands Institute for Higher Education (NIHA) and Institute of International Relations Clingendael, includes both theoretical and practical sessions including hypothetical scenarios. It will start at 9.00AM and last until 17.00 – the training schedule can be found below.

#### **About Prof. Dr. Paul Meerts:**

The training will be given by Prof. Paul Meerts who is an advisor at Clingendael and expert on international negotiation processes, is also a visiting professor in International Negotiation Analysis at the College of Europe (Bruges). In the past he was Head of Training and Education (1983-1989), Deputy Director (1990-2006) and Special Advisor to the Director of Clingendael (2006-2011). His current expertise is the international negotiations processes and currently training diplomats, civil servants and military officers in over ninety countries worldwide.
